


## PROCEDURE

### To disconnect the lower console cable connector:




1. Power off and unplug the unit.
2. Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove the motor cover.
3. Disconnect the console cable from the lower control board. The control board style and connector location varies by model <Figure 1>, <Figure 2>.

**Tip:** To identify the console cable, find the cord that extends from inside the right-side console mast, then follow its path to the LCB.



### To disconnect the upper console cable connector:

4. If the unit has covers between the console mast and console, remove them using a Phillips screwdriver <Figure 3>.
5. If the unit has handlebar extensions that connect the console to the console mast or frame, remove them using an Allen wrench <Figure 4>.
6. Using a 5MM Allen wrench, remove the bolts holding the console assembly to the mast <Figure 5>.
7. Tilt the right side of the console assembly upwards, then unclip the console cable.
8. Remove the console assembly from the frame.
9. Using electrical tape, secure the cable to the mast arm <Figure 6>.



## To replace the lower console cable:

10. Using electrical tape, attach the top of replacement the console cable to the bottom of the original console cable <Figure 7>.
11. Pull the old cable up until the new cable comes out of the console mast.

## To replace the upper console cable:

12. Using a screwdriver, remove the back console cover.
13. Unplug the cable from the upper board.
14. Attach and position the new upper console cable, then reassemble the console.

## To reassemble:

15. Clip in the new lower cable at the lower control board and at the console assembly.
16. Reattach the console assembly to the console mast.
17. Reattach the motor cover.
18. Test the unit.
